The Red Bank Wine's of the Week

White

Italy - Abbruzzo Pecorino, Tenuta Ulisse

A brilliant Pecorino, elegant fruit forward nose. Well balanced in palate, acidity creeps up but never overtakes the experience, apples, pears, subtle jasmine and mineral notes.

France - Loire Valley Chenin Blanc, Vouvray Sec, Château Moncontour

This wine is pale lemon in colour with youthful hues, and is reminiscent of green apples and white flowers. The palate is crisp, clean and beautifully balanced, with a long refreshing finish.

Red Wine

Australia - Adeliaide Shiraz, 16 Stops

This deep coloured Shiraz is youthful and vibrant, with a lovely dark fruit and spiced plum character on the nose. The oak supports rather than masks the fruit, which is bright and lively yet plush and fleshy on the palate. The tannins are ripe and silky, giving the wine a texture that is unusual at this price...

France - Southern Rhône Grenache/Syrah, Organic, Famille Perrin 'Nature' Côtes-du-Rhône

The nose has lovely notes of red and black fruits coupled with spicy, peppery notes. The tannins are ripe and plush, giving the wine excellent structure. Notes of blackcurrant and white pepper linger on the finish.

The palate is delightfully refreshing, with the elegant medium body very well balanced by a crisp acidity and mineral subtones. France - Chablis 69 Chardonnay, Domaine Passy Le Clou Golden colour. Expressive, floral, with a hint of white fruits (apple and pear). Mineral and citrus notes, well balanced by it's roundness and finesse. Italy - Piedmont 46 Cortese, Gavi di Gavi, La Giustiniana Lugarara Straw-yellow with a greenish hue. The wine's aromas of white fruit, stone fruit and lime zest are immediately beguiling and followed by a subtle yet persistent bouquet of green apples. The palate is well balanced with a fresh acidity and good structure. Pleasant almond notes linger on the finish. New Zealand - Marlborough 49 Sauvignon Blanc, Sileni Straits Intensely aromatic with vibrant flavours of passionfruit, ripe tropical fruit and gooseberry. The palate is well balanced, with fine acidity delivering a lingering finish. Portugal – Vinho Verde 38 Alvarinho/Loureiro, Quinta de Azevedo Vinho Verde Reserva This wine is clear and bright with greenish tints and an intense aroma of well-ripened fruit, such as peaches and nectarines. On the palate, it is creamy with aromatic notes of ripe fruit with great concentration. A lively acidity invites a long and balanced finish. Spain - Galicia, Rías Baixas 39 Albariño, Silandeiro A lime yellow colour with golden highlights. Full of ripe apples, apricots, and peach aromas typical of the varietal. On the palate, the wine is rich, mellow and well-balanced with juicy fruit and clean acidity. Rounded, with a long, off dry, minerally finish. South Africa - Paarl, Coastal Region 36 Viognier, Fairview The wine is a bright gold colour with papaya, tropical fruit and pear blossom aromas balanced by subtle spicy oak notes. The palate is rich and complex with flavours of honeycomb, apricot and orange on a fresh finish.

USA - California 62 Chardonnay, Mon Frere

Nose Aromas of citrus, pear and stone fruit lined with floral notes and a hint of nutmeg and vanilla on the finish. Palate A rich, round mouthfeel with perfectly balanced acidity and minerality followed by a refreshing finish.

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Argentina – Mendoza

Malbec, Particular Bianchi Grand Reserve Deep red colour with violet hues. On the nose it reveals a distinctive aroma of red fruit, cherry, ripe plum mingled with notes of spices, almonds, toasted coffee, coconut, and chocolate provided by the French and American oak. The mouthfeel is intense and robust, with a soft and delicate entry of sweet tannins, liquorice sensations, and long lingering. Austrailia – McLaren Vale, South Austrailia 40 Grenache, Willunga 100 A splendid, perfumed, spicy expression of Grenache. Fresh red fruit aromas and flavours and silky tannins combine on the palate that has great substance and structure. Well-balanced, with lingering hints of clove. France - Bordeaux 59 Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Des Trois Tours Deep ruby-red in colour, this wine has an inviting bouquet of red plum, black cherry and blackcurrant, with hints of spice. The palate is concentrated and supple, with smooth tannins and layers of bright red fruit. 69 Italy – Abbruzzo Montepulciano, D'Abruzzo DOP, Amaranta Ruby red color with garnet reflections, intense and persistent fragrance; The bouquet is intense, fruity, persistent, with notes of dried flowers, spice, liquorice, marasca cherries. The palate is stylish, velvety, almost creamy, compact with tannic structure, well balanced with a long aftertaste. 49 New Zealand - Marlborough Pinot Noir, Tinpot Hut This Pinot Noir is ruby red in colour with a purple hue. It has intense aromas of black cherry, blackberry and plum mingle with a hint of redcurrant. Savoury mushroom and toasty oak characters complete the attractive nose. On the palate, it has classic black cherry notes that dominate and are supported by hints of bramble. South Africa – Durbanville Hills 52 Pinotage, Durbanville Hills Deep red with purple edges. Bright dark fruit, blueberries, plums, sweet spice and hints of Turkish delight. Full bodied wine with grippy tannins, cinnamon, sweet plum and lingering after taste. Spain – Rioja Alta, Rioja 75 Tempranillo/Mazuelo, Bodegas LAN Rioja Gran Reserva On the nose, aromas of ripe red fruits combine with spicy vanilla, cinnamon and liquorice root notes, which are a result of the extended oak ageing. This wine is full bodied and round Rioja that is elegant, balanced and superbly layered on the palate. USA - California 48 Cabernet Sauvignon, Fog Mountain A deep garnet in the glass, opens with alluring aromas of dark red fruit. This luscious
