The Red Bank Wine's of the Week

White

Italy - Abruzzo
Pecorino, Tenuta Ulisse 39

A brilliant Pecorino, elegant fruit forward nose. Well balanced in palate, acidity creeps up but never overtakes the experience, apples, pears, subtle jasmine and mineral notes.

France - Loire Valley
Chenin Blanc, Vouvray Sec, Château Moncontour 42

This wine is pale lemon in colour with youthful hues, and is reminiscent of green apples and white flowers. The palate is crisp, clean and beautifully balanced, with a long refreshing finish.

Red Wine

Italy - Tuscany
Sangiovese/Canaiolo/Colorin, Organic Chianti, Poggiotondo 39

This wine is deep red in colour. The nose is elegant with a blend of ripe dark fruits and a hint of earthiness. The palate has supple, velvety tannins with flavours of spicy, sweet dark cherry and wild hedgerow and a soft mouthfeel leading to a long complex finish.

France - Southern Rhône
Grenache/Syrah, Organic, Famille Perrin 'Nature' Côtes-du-Rhône 43

The nose has lovely notes of red and black fruits coupled with spicy, peppery notes. The tannins are ripe and plush, giving the wine excellent structure. Notes of blackcurrant and white pepper linger on the finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Agua Santa, Colchagua, Chile A clean nose loaded with herbal and citrus notes. A fresh and crisp palate with good acidity before a long, persistent finish	6.75	26.5
Pinot Grigio, DOC, Amori, Della Venezie, Italy Aromas of ripe peach and pear with slight hints of flint. It is refreshing and crisp on the finish, on the palate, it is rich and well-balanced.	7	27.5
Fernao Pires/Arinto, Q.S.S Rare, Lisbon, Portugal Wine with a lemon color with greenish tinge, expressive aroma with lychee type fruit and fresh floral notes of lime. Crispy and refreshing.	7.25	28.5
Chardonnay, Whistling Duck, New South Wales, Australia Fresh and elegant, this wine has good fruit weight and aromas including apple and white peach, a lovely texture and a savoury edge.	7.5	29.5
Vermentino, Paul Mas, Pays d'Oc, Languedoc, France A beautiful Vermentino which appears in the glass bright light yellow. To the nose, this wine presents all sorts of grapefruit, lime, pink grapefruit, physalis and orange.	8	30.5

Cabernet Sauvignon, Agua Santa, Colchagua, Chile Intense aromas of blackberries and plums framed with subtle touches of cocoa and cedar. A grippy palate structure full of ripe cherries and currants.	6.75	26.5
Sangiovese/Primitivo, Cielo Via Mare, Puglia, Italy A curious blend of sangiovese and primitivo from the heel of Italy, Puglia, that has created a good anyday red that has great freshness from the sangiovese, and ripe black-cherry notes from the primitivo - light and delicious.	7	27.5
Tempranillo, Luciente, Rioja, Spain An elegant wine with the typical varietal character of the Tempranillo grape. Young wine, with the classic Rioja aromas of ripe plum and violet flowers with subtle hints of vanilla.	7.25	28.5
Merlot, Sainte Magdelaine, Languedoc, France The nose boasts aromas of fresh red cherry and plum. On the palate the tannins are ripe and plush, complimented by flavours of juicy red fruits.	7.5	29.5
Malbec, Finca Los Primos Bianchi, Mendoza, Argentina This Malbec is deep purple in colour. On the nose there are aromas of red fruits such as plums and blackberries, complemented by notes of chocolate.	8	30.5

White Wine

- Germany - Bechtheim, Rheinhessen** 39
Riesling, (Organic), Dreissigacker
Pale yellow in colour with youthful hues, this dry organic Riesling shows ripe fruit aromas of citrus, nectarine and apricot, paired with light spice notes. The palate is delightfully refreshing, with the elegant medium body very well balanced by a crisp acidity and mineral subtones.
- France - Chablis** 69
Chardonnay, Domaine Passy Le Clou
Golden colour. Expressive, floral, with a hint of white fruits (apple and pear). Mineral and citrus notes, well balanced by it's roundness and finesse.
- Italy - Piedmont** 46
Cortese, Gavi di Gavi, La Giustiniana Lugarara
Straw-yellow with a greenish hue. The wine's aromas of white fruit, stone fruit and lime zest are immediately beguiling and followed by a subtle yet persistent bouquet of green apples. The palate is well balanced with a fresh acidity and good structure. Pleasant almond notes linger on the finish.
- New Zealand - Marlborough** 49
Sauvignon Blanc, Sileni Straits
Intensely aromatic with vibrant flavours of passionfruit, ripe tropical fruit and gooseberry. The palate is well balanced, with fine acidity delivering a lingering finish.
- Portugal - Vinho Verde** 38
Alvarinho/Loureiro, Quinta de Azevedo Vinho Verde Reserva
This wine is clear and bright with greenish tints and an intense aroma of well-ripened fruit, such as peaches and nectarines. On the palate, it is creamy with aromatic notes of ripe fruit with great concentration. A lively acidity invites a long and balanced finish.
- Spain - Galicia, Rías Baixas** 43
Albariño, Silandeiro
A lime yellow colour with golden highlights. Full of ripe apples, apricots, and peach aromas typical of the varietal. On the palate, the wine is rich, mellow and well-balanced with juicy fruit and clean acidity. Rounded, with a long, off dry, minerally finish.
- South Africa - Paarl, Coastal Region** 37
Viognier, Fairview
The wine is a bright gold colour with papaya, tropical fruit and pear blossom aromas balanced by subtle spicy oak notes. The palate is rich and complex with flavours of honeycomb, apricot and orange on a fresh finish.
- USA - California** 59
Chardonnay, Mon Frere
Nose Aromas of citrus, pear and stone fruit lined with floral notes and a hint of nutmeg and vanilla on the finish. Palate A rich, round mouthfeel with perfectly balanced acidity and minerality followed by a refreshing finish.

Red Wine

- Argentina - Mendoza** 59
Malbec, Particular Bianchi Reserva
Deep red colour with violet hues. On the nose it reveals a distinctive aroma of red fruit, cherry, ripe plum mingled with notes of spices, almonds, toasted coffee, coconut, and chocolate provided by the French and American oak. The mouthfeel is intense and robust, with a soft and delicate entry of sweet tannins, liquorice sensations, and long lingering.
- Portugal - Lisbon** 36
Touriga Nacional/Cabernet Sauvignon/Shiraz, Q.S.S Rare
This wine has an intense ruby color, with expressive notes of berry and an aroma with chocolaty notes. The palate is soft and elegant, beautiful and full of rich flavour.
- France - Bordeaux** 59
Merlot/Cabernet Sauvignon, Chateau Des Trois Tours
Deep ruby-red in colour, this wine has an inviting bouquet of red plum, black cherry and blackcurrant, with hints of spice. The palate is concentrated and supple, with smooth tannins and layers of bright red fruit.
- Italy - Abruzzo** 69
Montepulciano, D'Abruzzo DOP, Amaranta
Ruby red color with garnet reflections, intense and persistent fragrance; The bouquet is intense, fruity, persistent, with notes of dried flowers, spice, liquorice, marasca cherries. The palate is stylish, velvety, almost creamy, compact with tannic structure, well balanced with a long aftertaste.
- New Zealand - Marlborough** 49
Pinot Noir, Tinpot Hut
This Pinot Noir is ruby red in colour with a purple hue. It has intense aromas of black cherry, blackberry and plum mingle with a hint of redcurrant. Savoury mushroom and toasty oak characters complete the attractive nose. On the palate, it has classic black cherry notes that dominate and are supported by hints of bramble.
- Australia (South) - McLaren Vale** 48
Cabernet Sauvignon, 'Pride of the Fleurieu' Dandelion Vineyards
This Cabernet Sauvignon has a dark purple colour with bright violet edges. On the nose, it has aromas of blueberry, blackberry, raspberry and cassis, with hints of menthol and fennel. The palate is rich, deep and intensely flavoured with blueberry and blackberry.
- Spain - Rioja Alta, Rioja** 69
Tempranillo/Mazuelo, Bodegas LAN Rioja Reserva
This wine is intense garnet in colour. Aromas of juicy plum, cherries and blackberries are married with notes of vanilla and spices from oak ageing and subtle earthy hints from bottle age. The palate is exceptionally well-structured, with velvety tannins and a vibrant acidity which carries the complex flavours onto the lingering finish.
- USA - California** 52
Cabernet Sauvignon, Fog Mountain
A deep garnet in the glass, opens with alluring aromas of dark red fruit. This luscious Cabernet Sauvignon presents rich flavors of dried plums, Medjool dates, red currants and bright berries flavours on the palate.
